

RMIT International Industry Experience and Research Program (RIIERP)

Students at RMIT can undertake for-credit and paid work experience, traineeships and research with more than 100 top global companies through the RMIT International Industry Experience and Research Program (RIIERP). [The overwhelming majority of companies are in German-speaking countries or in countries where the company is a subsidiary of a global German company.]

Since 1992, more than 1800 students have been placed in six to 12-month paid internships.
